



SUMMER READING 6TH, 7TH, & 8TH GRADE STUDENTS

There is no required reading list for Summer Reading for Middle School students for 2008-09. Each student will read enough books to fulfill a certain page requirement. Students may read books that they choose with their parents' permission. Suggestions: Classic novels, Caldecott Medal and Honor Winners, Newberry Medal and Honor Winners, Christian fiction, autobiographies and biographies.

All students will keep a journal of the books that are read during the summer. Each journal entry will have the following elements:

- 1.) Title of Book
- 2.) Author
- 3.) Date read
- 4.) Number of pages
- 5.) Main characters (If applicable)
- 6.) A brief summary of the book in paragraph form consisting of at least 5 sentences.
- 7.) Would you recommend this book? Why? Or Why not?
- 8.) Parent signature supporting the reading of each book

Page Requirements

6th Grade - 400 pages total

7th Grade - 500 pages total

8th Grade - 600 pages total

At the beginning of the year, you will turn in your journal in order to receive your Summer Reading grade.
